

February 2022 Howe of Fife & Taycoast Community Council Report

Introduction

Community Officers PC's Lowe and Haddow along with assistance from Response officers have been targeting speeding motorists and antisocial behaviour this month. With the restrictions easing, they have also carried out some local visits engaging with young persons. Road Policing Officers have also been out in the area providing visibility and assistance as we aim to keep our communities safer.

Calls Received (up to end of February 2022)

Since 1st February 2022, Police have received 210 calls in the Howe of Fife and Taycoast area resulting in 21 crimes being recorded. This breaks down as follows:

They were provided with advice regarding their future career and what is involved in local policing and we look forward to working with them in the future.





As part of their roles PC's Lowe and Haddow carry out Firearms enquiries which consists of visiting certificate holders, carrying out inspections of certificate holder's weapons and the property where they are stored, ensuring the correct security is in place and compiling reports for the purpose of granting and renewing certificates.

Whilst carrying out a routine enquiry PC's Lowe and Haddow seized 7 air weapons from the property of a certificate holder who was breaching his conditions.
