

June 2022 Howe of Fife & Taycoast Community Council Report

Introduction

This month Community Officers PC's Lowe and Haddow have been abstracted for a number of shifts to assist in St. Andrews with the Graduation Parades of University Students. They have also with assistance from Response Officers been tackling reports of anti-social behaviour and canvassing for volunteers to participate in the Community Speed Watch Campaign.

As a result of the reports of anti-social behaviour, officers have identified and reported 5 individuals found to be responsible for some of the unacceptable behaviour in the Strathmiglo area and 1 individual in the Freuchie area.

Upcoming Events

During the month of July Officers will be deployed to the 150th Open Golf held in St. Andrews which is a prestigious event that they are looking forward to being a part of.

Calls Received (up to end of June 2022)

Since 1st June 2022, Police have received 199 calls in the Howe of Fife and Taycoast area resulting in 26 crimes being recorded. This breaks down as follows:
