

May 2022 Howe of Fife & Taycoast Community Council Report

Introduction

Community Officers PC's Lowe and Haddow along with assistance from Response officers have been involved with tackling reports of anti-social behaviour this month along with illegal fishing. Officers have attended these reports and actively engaged with offenders to prevent further issues arising.

Calls Received (up to end of May 2022)

Since 1st May 2022, Police have received 200 calls in the Howe of Fife and Taycoast area resulting in 30 crimes being recorded. This breaks down as follows:


