

March 2022 Howe of Fife & Taycoast Community Council Report

Introduction

Community Officers PC's Lowe and Haddow along with assistance from Response officers have been targeting speeding motorists and antisocial behaviour this month. Officers have been involved in targeting anti-social behaviour following reports of local youths causing a number of issues. With the clocks changing, and the Easter Holidays upon us, officers will be engaging with local youths on a more regular basis to prevent any future issues arising.

Calls Received (up to end of March 2022)

Since 1st March 2022, Police have received 139 calls in the Howe of Fife and Taycoast area resulting in 14 crimes being recorded. This breaks down as follows:
