

# **April 2022 Howe of Fife & Taycoast Community Council Report**

## Introduction

Community Officers PC's Lowe and Haddow along with assistance from Response officers have been involved with tackling reports of anti-social behaviour this month. Officers have attended these reports and actively engaged with the youths to prevent further issues arising.

## Calls Received (up to end of April 2022)

Since 1st April 2022, Police have received 199 calls in the Howe of Fife and Taycoast area resulting in 27 crimes being recorded. This breaks down as follows:

## **Auchtermuchty**

39 calls to the police consisting of Concern for Persons, Assist member of the Public, Road Traffic Incidents, Threatening and abusive behaviour, Communications matter

5 recorded crimes -1 x Threatening and abusive behaviour, 3 x Road Traffic Offences, 1 x Communications Offence.
